



The Financial Services and Markets Authority (FSMA) warns the public against the activities of Daiju Commodity Markets, a company that offers investment services.

Daily Commodity Markets is **not an authorized investment firm** in Belgium. It is therefore not allowed to provide investment services in or from Belgium.

Moreover, according to the information available to the FSMA, the activities proposed could be of a fraudulent nature, i.e. **boiler room fraud**. More information on this form of fraud is available in the [general warning](#) published by the FSMA on 5 November 2018.

The FSMA therefore **strongly advises against responding to any offer of financial services** made by Daily Commodity Markets and **against transferring** money to any account number it might mention.
