

The CMVM (Portuguese Securities Market Commission) issues a warning for investors to the fact that **Libra Markets**, with the website <https://libramarkets.com/> is not authorised to carry out any type of financial intermediation activity in Portugal, under article 295 (1) paragraphs a) and b) of the Portuguese Securities Code, contrary to what have been disclosed.

The CMVM clarifies that this entity is not legally qualified to carry out advertising or prospecting for clients aimed into financial intermediation contracts.
